What is the Moses Cone Health System Academic Scholarship Program?

The Academic Scholarship Program provides educational assistance to students enrolled in various healthcare programs, such as Nursing, Rehabilitation, Pharmacy, Radiation Oncology, Anesthesiology and others. Participants can receive educational assistance ranging from \$1,250 to \$10,000 per academic year, and may have an opportunity to become a member of the Moses Cone Health System upon successful completion of their program.

What are the eligibility requirements?

- Proof of acceptance in an accredited program.
- Acceptable grade point average (GPA) and official transcript from most recent educational program.
- Completed Moses Cone Health System Academic Scholarship Program application.
- Letters of recommendation and references from key individuals.
- Must have at least a Level III performance rating (if Moses Cone Health System employee) and no active corrective action from current employer.
- Successfully pass a drug screen.
- Proof of acceptable criminal record.
- Proof of authorization to work in the United States.

Selection of participants for the program will be based on academic achievement, recommendation/references, personal interview by the appropriate department director and prior experience.

What is the participant's obligation?

When selected to participate in the Academic Scholarship Program, you must meet the following criteria:

- Maintain status as a full-time student with at least a 3.0 grade point average.
- Provide proof of successfully completed course of training.
- Successfully pass State Boards and receive licensure/certification within established program guidelines, if professionally required.
- Agree to work full-time after graduation within Moses Cone Health System one year for each year you receive the scholarship.

If this obligation is not met, the academic scholarship will be payable in full immediately, *including all applicable fees and penalties.*
