Our Program

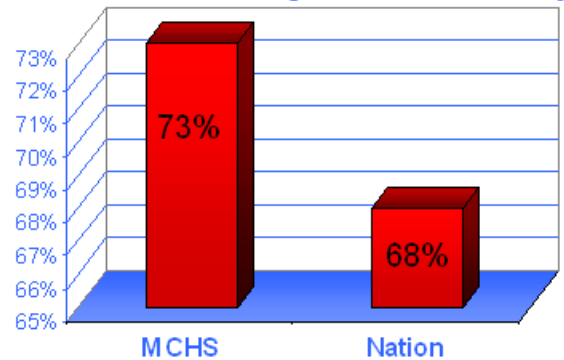
The caring staff at the Moses Cone Health System Inpatient Rehabilitation Center has been providing stroke rehabilitation services to patients and their families for over 20 years. The Stroke Program at the Inpatient Rehab Center is staffed by an experienced and dedicated team of physicians and rehabilitation professionals who work together with patients and families to provide personalized, comprehensive and fully integrated care.

During Fiscal Year 2008, we cared for 223 stroke survivors. Our patients had an average age of 69. All patients had a physician specializing in physical rehabilitation oversee their program. The rehabilitation physician and team members worked with each patient and family to create a personal treatment plan to help them regain as much independence as possible, with the goal of returning to home and the community.

Returning Home

The ability to return to home and the community is an important outcome. The Stroke Program at the Moses Cone Health System Inpatient Rehabilitation Center exceeds the national average for discharges back home and to the community. Stroke Survivors spent an average of 14 days in the Rehab Center.

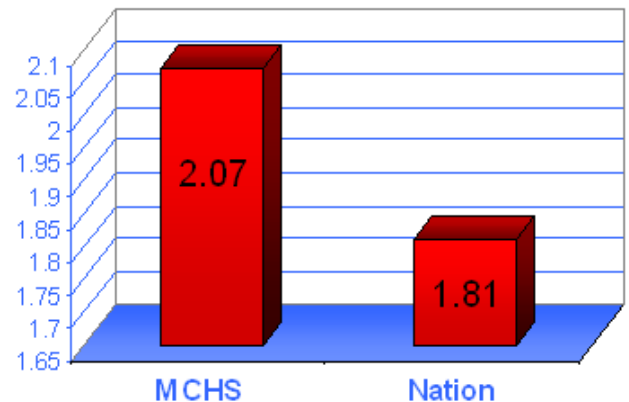
Patients Returning To Community



Gaining Independence

Regaining independence is a primary focus in rehab. The rehabilitation physician and team members work with patients and families to create a personal treatment plan to help each patient regain as much independence as possible, with the goal of returning to home and the community. Patients served in the Moses Cone Health System Stroke Program experience more functional recovery than the national average for rehab centers.

Satisfaction With Program

Patient Satisfaction is also an important outcome. Following discharge, patients are asked to complete a satisfaction survey. In 2008, 90.2% of our stroke survivors and families said that they would recommend the Moses Cone Inpatient Rehabilitation Center to family and friends as a place of quality care.
