



“Community benefit” is an industry term that refers to the total cost of providing financial assistance to uninsured and underinsured patients; subsidizing Medicare and Medicaid reimbursements; and financing other services that address vital needs but do not pay for themselves. For its year ended September 30, 2012, Moses H Memorial Hospital total Community Benefit was \$198,992,047 which was 23.24% of its operating expenses. This amount includes \$165,131,426 in financial assistance costs provided by Moses H Cone Memorial Hospital as defined by and required to be disclosed by NC law.
