THEY ARE TESTED AND EFFECTIVE

110,000+ volunteers participated in three vaccine clinical trials. Clinical trials noted the vaccines are highly effective in preventing COVID-19 with no serious safety concerns.



THEY ARE SAFE

The vaccines are safe and prevent COVID-19. The FDA has authorized the vaccines for use and will continue to monitor them for safety.



MASK UP!

Even after receiving your vaccine it is still recommended that you wear a mask, wash your hands and remain socially distant.



CELLS FIGHT THE VIRUS

When you receive the vaccine, it causes your immune system to produce antibodies to COVID-19 and to activate T-cells that can destroy infected cells.

ONE OR TWO DOSES REQUIRED

Pfizer = two doses, 21 days apart or more.
Moderna = two doses, 28 days apart or more.
Johnson & Johnson = one dose.



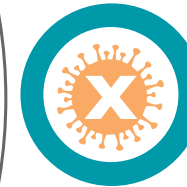
NO MAJOR SIDE EFFECTS EXPECTED

Some people may have a sore arm, arm warmth, fatigue or a low-grade fever a day or two after receiving the vaccine.



THE VACCINE CANNOT GIVE YOU COVID-19

The vaccines do not use the live virus that causes COVID-19.



IT'S FREE

The COVID-19 vaccine will be available for free, even if you don't have insurance.
