The Cone Health Employee Health Plan Specialty Medication Clinic (CHEHPSMC) is a Cone Health offered benefit to those who are covered under the Cone Health medical plans* and who take select Specialty medications**. As of January 1, 2022, Cone Health has added additional Specialty medications to the program to provide this benefit to more members. These additions are highlighted below.

If you take one of these medications, we invite you to participate in the Employee Health Plan Specialty Medication Clinic. For your participation, you will not be required to pay the Specialty copay. If you do not participate, your copay assistance card will not be applied, and you will be responsible for the copay.

There's no need for you to do anything at this time. The next time you fill your prescription(s) at one of the Cone Health Outpatient Pharmacies, they will have the Clinical Pharmacist Practitioner contact you to schedule an appointment at the Specialty Medication Clinic or by video visit. During your appointment, you will review your medication, and have the opportunity to ask questions about medication compliance and side effects. Our goal is to offer you an enhanced experience and help to ensure that you are successful with your medication therapy. After your visit with the Clinical Pharmacist Practitioner, a new prescription will be sent electronically to the Wesley Long Outpatient Pharmacy (our Specialty Pharmacy) for you to pick up in time to continue your therapy or for your added convenience, the pharmacy can mail the medication to your home with no additional charge. Please notify the Clinical Pharmacist Practitioner if your doctor changes your prescription.

The clinic is located at the Community Health & Wellness Center, 201 E. Wendover Ave, Greensboro. Clinic hours are by appointment only between 8 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday through Friday, and the Clinical Pharmacist Practitioner can be flexible depending on plan participant's availability. There is also a video visit option for your added convenience.
